

CLAT Exam Pattern for PG

The CLAT PG exam is designed for candidates seeking admission to postgraduate law programs (LL.M) at National Law Universities (NLUs) in India. The exam pattern of CLAT LLM assesses advanced legal knowledge and analytical skills.

The CLAT PG exam lasts for 120 minutes (2 hours). It is conducted in an offline format at different exam centers across the country. The language of the question paper is English only.

There are 120 objective-type questions in the CLAT PG exam, for maximum marks of 120.
