

# CLAT Exam Pattern for UG

The duration of the CLAT exam is 2 hours (120 minutes). The exam is conducted in an offline mode, and the language of the question paper is English only.

The CLAT UG exam pattern consists of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs). There are a total of 120 questions in the CLAT exam, covering five different sections.

## Sections in CLAT UG Exam

There are five sections in the CLAT paper pattern for undergraduates:

Subject	No. of Questions	Weightage
English Language	22-26 questions	20%
Current Affairs, including General Knowledge	28-32 questions	25%
Legal Reasoning	28-32 questions	25%
Logical Reasoning	22-26 questions	20%
Quantitative Techniques	10-14 questions	10%

## Marking Scheme

Answer Type	Marks
Correct Answer	+1 mark
Incorrect Answer	-0.25 marks
Unattempted Question	0 marks

The CLAT exam has a straightforward marking scheme:

- **Correct Answer:** Each correct response earns the candidate 1 mark.
- **Incorrect Answer:** Each incorrect response results in a deduction of 0.25 marks from the total score.
- **Unattempted Question:** No marks are awarded or deducted for questions that are left unattempted.
